

Closing statement of the group spokesperson

Many important points have been raised. Thank you for the explanations and the answers provided.

It is clear that the retirement home project is the one that will require significant financial resources in the coming years. However, we must be careful not to save in the wrong places and not to reduce space excessively in order to gain more rooms at the expense of quality of life. Even though this is an important project, care must be taken to ensure that other projects do not suffer as a result or fall by the wayside. Before this happens, we should be prepared to take out a loan.

A master plan for infrastructure is a positive step. Here too, we would appreciate being kept informed once things progress.

Even though we sit in opposition as the CSV, we strive to contribute our ideas. We are not an opposition that opposes everything on principle. We support projects that we consider sensible and beneficial for the development of the municipality. However, the core and the importance of certain projects do not always align with what we, as the CSV, can identify with. Our priorities are different.

We would welcome receiving occasional brief updates on the status of various projects or studies — simply to know what is underway, especially since we too are often faced with questions from the public. We continue to rely on democracy and transparency, as well as fair cooperation, and we strive to maintain a constructive opposition policy.
