

Guy Weirich Announces His Departure from the Municipal Council

At the end of the Municipal Council meeting on 10 July 2026, Guy Weirich announced his resignation, stating:

"This was my last Municipal Council meeting. I will resign from my mandate with effect from 24 July 2026. After eleven and a half years on the Municipal Council, halfway through the current term of office, and at the age of 77, I feel that the time has come for me to step down.

Back in 2011, it took a great deal of persuasion before I agreed to become involved in local politics here in Bertrange. Today, however, I can honestly say that I would not want to have missed these years, any more than I would other important stages of my life. The positive experiences have far outweighed everything else. This commitment has truly been worthwhile.

I wish my political group renewed momentum through the arrival of a new councillor, and I hope it will continue to serve our municipality with the same dedication and passion.

I also wish the College of Mayor and Aldermen and the Municipal Council every success in continuing to make the right decisions for Bertrange, in the best interests of all its citizens. This requires long-term vision, particularly with regard to the two major development projects, *A Schwalls* and the *Triangle de Helfent*. Whether I will live to see the completion of the new *Triangle de Helfent* is not in my hands. I do, however, hope that it will include a large green recreational area where future generations can enjoy spending time and draw new strength.

At this moment, I would simply like to say thank you:

- to everyone who has placed their trust in me time and again;
- to my fellow members of the Municipal Council, because throughout all these years we have succeeded in putting the interests of Bertrange above our differences;
- and to the entire municipal staff. I have witnessed an extraordinary level of commitment to our community, and I would also like to express my sincere appreciation for that today.
